Can you make a spider's web?

What you need: paper plates, black paint, string, pipe cleaners, scissors.

Instructions: paint the paper plate black and cut slits around the edge of the plate. Use string and wrap it around the plate to create a web.

Talk to your child about the spider in the story and what he did. Discuss where spiders live and how it is different to where we live.



Can you create a spider print pattern?

What you need: toilet rolls, googly eyes, paint, paper, pictures of spiders.

Questions: How many legs do spiders have? Can you describe how spiders move? Can you talk about how spiders are different from other minibeasts? Introduce the word arachnid and explain that spiders are not insects, but they are arachnids because they have 8 legs rather than 6 legs. What else can you find out about spiders?
