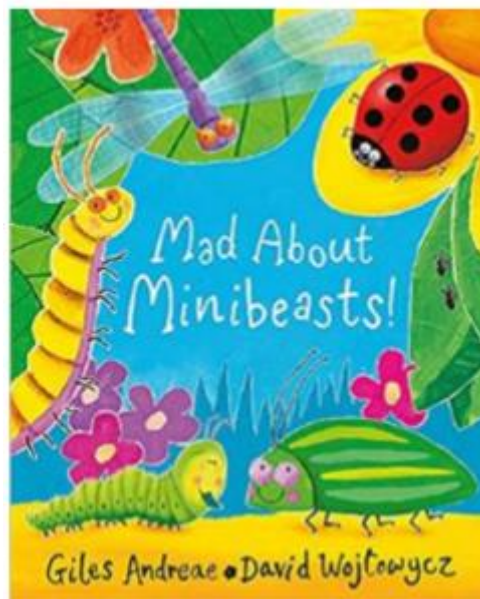

Summer Term – Week 2 – Reading and Context

Book of the week: Mad about Minibeasts by Giles Andreae and David Wojtowycz

The children will be continuing to look at Mad about Minibeasts but by this stage they should be vaguely familiar with some minibeast and may be beginning to ask questions and show an interest in wanting to find out more. This week should focus more on discussions around the current season, planting, the environment and where food comes from.



Reading

Listen to the story and continue to familiarise yourself with minibeasts. What minibeasts can you name? Where might you find them? Can you describe what they look like? How many legs do they have?
