Pupil Premium Expenditure Evaluation 2017.18

The Governors and Senior Leadership Team at the school believe that every child is an important member of our community and should be encouraged and challenged to achieve their full potential. The school budget is set by governors entirely on this basis – the key investment priority is always on initiatives that support all of our children to progress as governors, staff and parents would wish. The Pupil Premium Grant is just one part of the overall funding we invest to achieve this.

National rate

A national rate of 53p per hour per eligible Pupil Premium pupil. Providers will receive £302.10 for each eligible child who takes up the full <u>570 hours of state-funded early education</u> they are entitled to.

Schools will also receive £1,900 for each looked after pupil who are identified in the <u>January 2017</u> school census or the <u>alternative provision census</u> as having left local-authority care as a result of one of the following:

- adoption
- a special guardianship order
- a child arrangements order (previously known as a residence order)
- who has been in local-authority care for 1 day or more
- recorded as both eligible for FSM in the last 6 years and as being looked after (or as having left local-authority care)
