## Lucy and Tom at the Seaside

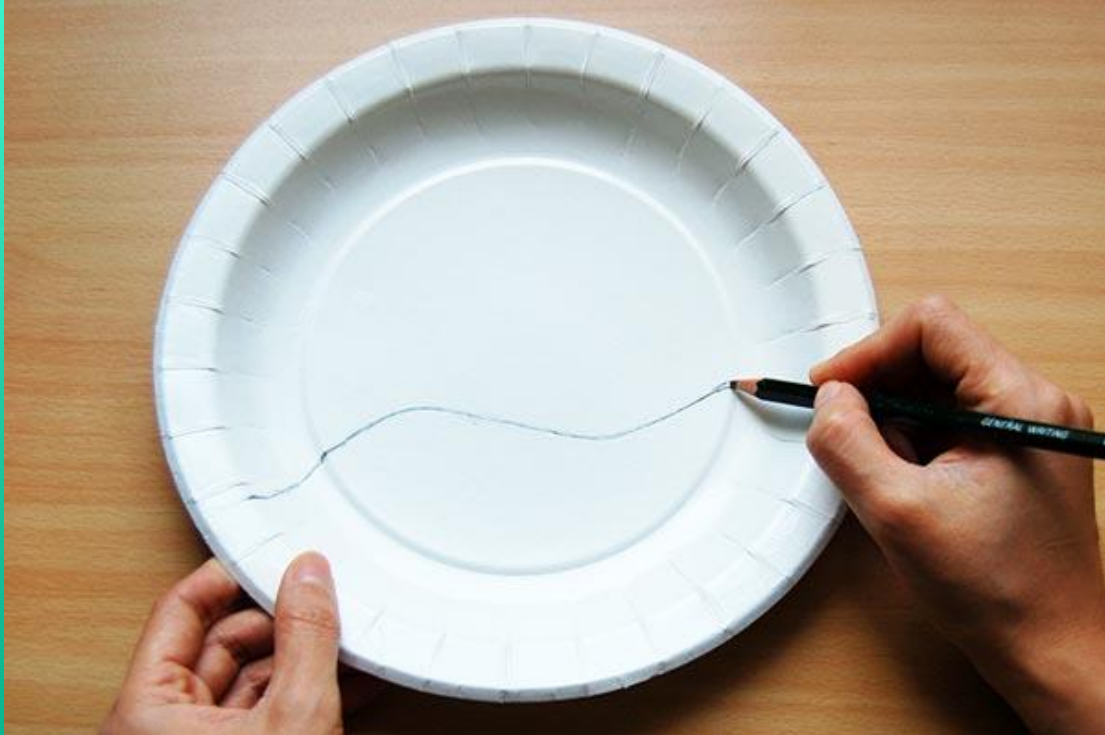

Can you create a beach scene using a variety of materials?



Begin with a paper plate or any other resources of your choice.

Draw a wavy line to separate the sea from the sand





Paint, colour or collage one half of the plate blue.

What do you think this will be?

On the other half of the plate you can create the sand. This can done using salt dough, lentils, couscous, rice krispies or even chickpea flour.



Make a tree trunk by rolling a small rectangular piece of brown construction paper. Tape or glue the edge in place.

Create leaves from a small rectangular piece of green paper. Cut evenly-spaced slits along its long side.

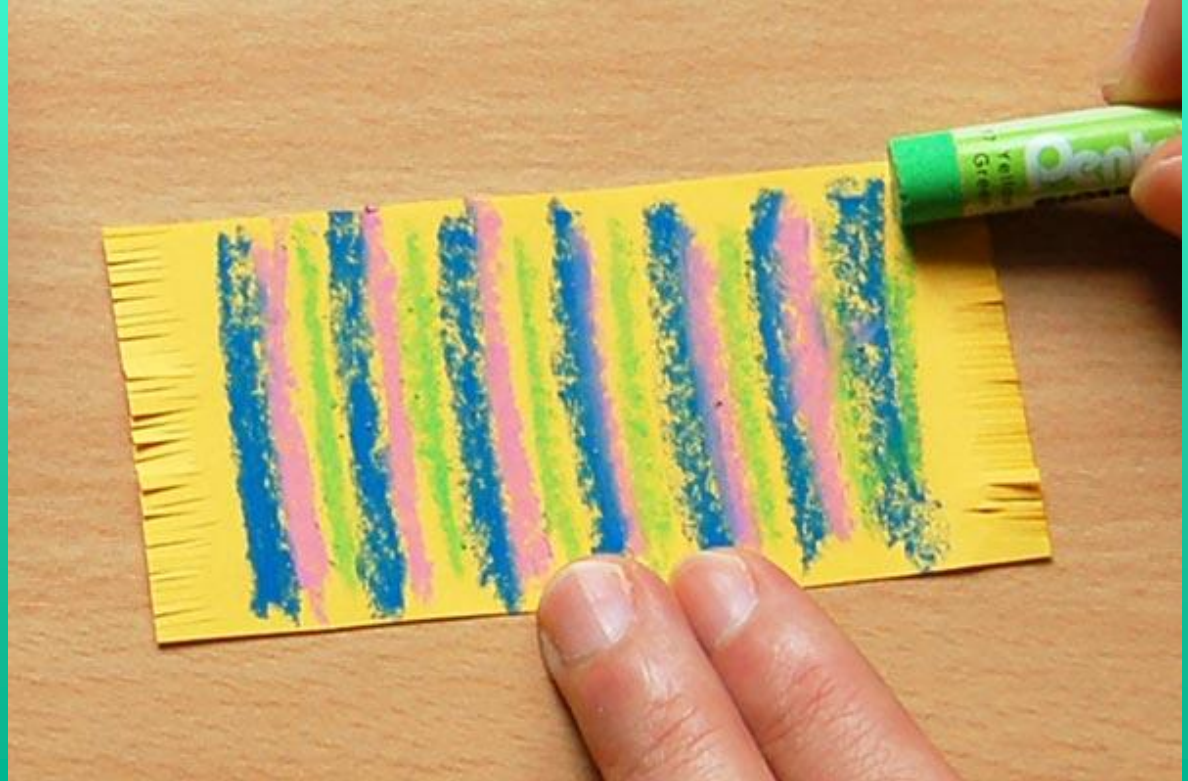
Roll the green paper. Insert the uncut side into the top of the tree trunk.

Carefully open up the fringes.





Create a beach towel by using a rectangular piece of paper. Draw some colourful stripes on it and then snip the ends to create a fringe.





You can add more detail to your beach scene using items around you or you can use any left over salt dough.
