

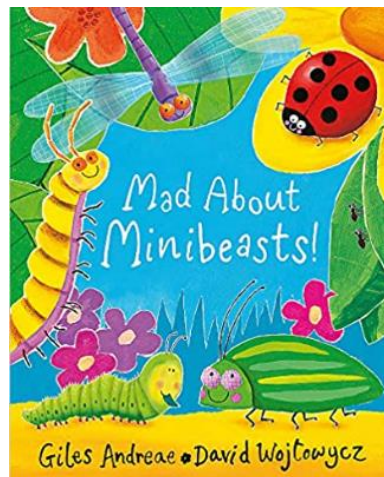
# ACACIA NURSERY HOME LEARNING

**Book of the week:** Mad about Minibeasts by Giles Andreae and David Wojtowycz

**Reading:** Mad About Minibeasts- Giles Andreae David Wojtowycz.



Listen to the story and familiarise yourself with minibeasts. What minibeasts can you name? Where might you find them? Can you describe what they look like? How many legs do they have? How do they grow or change? How do they move? What do they eat? Think about features such as the number of legs, whether they crawl or fly. Read this book or listen to the story on Youtube every day as it is good for your child to have some repetition for them to fully take all the information in. It may be that you only focus on a couple of pages at a time. Read to child and then talk about the pictures and what the child remembers hearing.
